Health Corner

Restless Leg Syndrome (Willis Ekbom disease)

- Is one of the common sleep related movement disorder.
 5-10% in adults have this problem, more in women.
 Exact data is not available in children and often mistaken for growing pain.
- Risk factors are: Iron deficiency anaemia Diabetes
 Rheumatoid Arthritis Kidney failure Parkinson's disease Antidepressant medicines First generation antihistamines Alcoholics Smokers.
- Features: feeling tighten sensations in legs, crawling sensation, aching and disturbs sleep leading to irritability, depressed mood and day time sleepiness. These symptoms intensify during relaxation, reading studying, trying to sleep, quite wakefulness. It is similar to yawn
- Mechanism: partly known as possible Dopamine in brain and iron system anomalies, runs in some families.
- Diagnosis: By clinical only. No specific tests to prove the disease

Do's

- Stretch the leg muscles and move
- Can use vibratory stimulation device, helps some to improve the sleep
- See your family physician to rule out other causes, if needed
- Encourage yoga exercises
- Take dopamine agonist medicine only with the advice of your doctor

Don'ts

- Don't sit idle
- Don't do unnecessary tests by self
- Don't take sleeping pills without your physicians advice
- Reduce alcohol consumptions
- · Stop tobacco smoking
- · Avoid too many pain killers
- Sometimes endurance better than therapy






