

## **Decoding of Cough**



**Prof Dr H Paramesh** 

- Cough is a protective reflex to remove irritation of respiratory tract. mainly. It is the "Voice of the Lungs". major psycho socio economic health burden.
- Normally one can have dry cough 10-15 time per day and maximum 34 times without disturbing sleep.
- In India we call Chronic Cough lasting more than 2 weeks duration in children. It is variable in duration in many countries.
- The respiratory mucus membrane on its surface has cough receptors which are highly sensitive to the quality of the air (smoke, scents •

air, change in humidity, smoke of chillies etc)

- The cough receptors beneath the mucus membrane they respond to tickling of throat, speech, eating, inhalation of particles.
- After a bout of viral cold the cough center is hypersensitive and lasts for 21 days and peaks at 10days.
- The prevalence of chronic cough is increased in children from 8% to 21.25% of the time, it in the past 2 decade in Bengaluru.
- The most common cause for Chronic cough is allergic rhinosinusitis and asthma
- 92% is diagnosed clinically only, 8% needs tests, if it is a wet, sleep disturbed cough with red flag signs:
- Cough in new born period, blood in sputum, Sudden onset without cold,

No response to treatment, If your doctor finds some abnormal clinical signs on examination.

#### Do's

- Cover your mouth with cotton hanky (respiratory etiquette)
- Keep 3 feet away from the people
- with infective cough Strict hand washing
- For dry hacking cough use honey with pepper or turmeric before sleep
- Elevate the head end of bed and sleep side ways
- Drink warm water
- Can use vaporub over nose, neck, behind ears.
- Consult your family doctor if cough persists.

#### Don'ts

- Exposure to cold dry air
- Use of Nylon, silk, satin hankies
- Taking too many cough medicines Taking antibiotics, unnecessarily
- Getting unnecessary tests without
- the recommendation of your family doctor
- Use of cold water Moving suddenly from warm to cold temperature.




