# **Current Concepts on Nutrition for Good Health**

- Indian Adages on Nutritional Health are:
  - One who knows what to eat and how to eat don't get diseases.
    Whoever is the father, under and malnutrition is the mother of the disease
- EAT Lancet commission Diet –2019 observation recommended by WHO are –

By using the local, less expensive food items while meeting the minimum required for all nutrients adequately with slight increased intake in low income countries from animal source, fruits and vegetables will cost about \$2.84 (Rs-200)/person/day. Nearly 38.4% of South Asian countries cannot afford it.

 Food safety standards authority of India as of Nov 2019 recommend.

To avoid high fat, salt, sugar in food Convert school campus into EAT RIGHT SCHOOLS EAT ADEQUATELY: Wholesome food 70-80% food of the menu EAT MODERATELY: Packed foods in small proportion EAT SPARINGLY: High fat, salt and sugar foods

- Our traditional home made food where we mix foods, sprouts, marinate in curds, tempering in oil and garnishing the food has proved its values gives all the nutrients needed.




